Lodging Information

Camp Bratton Green currently has several lodging options for individuals, families, and/or friends. CBG cabins are available with 9 bunks in a common area and a shared bathroom. Cabin Staff Rooms are located at the side of each cabin in a separate space contain 1 bunk with a single bed at the top and a queen bed at the bottom. Each staff room has its own bathroom as well. Big House rooms are also available with 2 single beds and a bathroom in each room. The Big House also boasts additional amenities such as a large common area and a kitchen. Finally, Gray Center Cottages are available and contain 2 single beds in each room, a common space in the center of the cottage.
